### **Notice of Claim**

Date of Issuance: February 15, 2012

Notice is hereby given that all unoccupied public lands, watercourses, subsurface waters, and water bodies within the boundaries of the drainage basins described below are claimed by Timberwolf on behalf of and for the primary benefit, conservation and continued subsistence of the contained ecosystems and any and all plant or animal species subsisting therein by right of natural and prior occupancy.

For purposes of this claim

drainage basin means and includes all lands, waters, watercourses and water bodies (surface and subsurface, ephemeral, intermittent or permanent) draining to the named main stem watercourse, downstream to specified points and locations within the boundaries of the claimed lands described below;

unoccupied means not held under deed of title by parties other than the Crown in right of the Government of Alberta or the Government of Canada, and not subject to prior claims by any First Nation, as at the date of issuance of this notice.

#### Claimed Lands

All unoccupied lands and waters in and including the Carbondale River drainage basin downstream to its confluence with the Castle River.

All unoccupied lands and waters in and including the Castle River drainage basin downstream to and including its confluence with the Carbondale River.

All unoccupied lands and waters in and including the Screwdriver Creek drainage basin downstream to its confluence with the Castle River.

All unoccupied lands and waters in and including the Beaver Mines Creek drainage basin downstream to its confluence with the Castle River.

All unoccupied lands and waters in and including the Mill Creek drainage basin downstream to and including its confluence with Gladstone Creek.

All unoccupied lands and waters in and including the Pincher, Drywood, South Drywood, Spionkop and Yarrow Creek drainage basins downstream to the boundary of Improvement District 6 as it is at the date of issuance of this notice.
